



- 1. Coorg Disaster Relief Fund contributions were made by Kodavakoota members, non members, multinational corporations & voluntary organizations that came forward to rescue the people of flood affected areas in KALUR & surrounding areas in Coorg
- 2. **Project Coorg** is a partnership with BHAVANS (Bhartiya Vidya Bhavan) to set up a self sustained spice production unit & channel it to customers through efficient supply chain. Today it's fully operated by the woman of KALUR whose families were affected in 2018 floods
- 3. Collaboration with Lions Club, Gonikoppal to plant saplings & wild forest trees in flood affected areas to prevent any further soil erosion
- **4. Sai Shankar Education Trust** is an English medium school that has accommodated kids of people who were severely impacted. The money was utilized to set up a computer lab that's fully functional today and kids have been using it as part of their academic curriculum
- 5. Clean Coorg initiative was to set up large size recycle & thrash bins across Coorg that will be collected on weekly basis by a recycle management company in Mysore. The program educated local people on waste segregation & efficient garbage management



2020 Initiatives – Work in Progress

	Initiatives	\$ Amount (Projected)
1.	Project COORG: Expansion & scaling of current spice production unit set up in KALUR due to increase in demand from local retailers. Setting up stores outside Coorg is also part of expansion plan. The amount is used for paying stipend to 32-35 woman from different Kodava families at Rs. 3000/- per month for next 6 months so that the current revenue can be used for the plant expansion & widening the distribution channels	\$ 9,000
2.	Ramakrishna Old Age Home: The facility needs maintenance and people living in the old age home needs nurse assistance. Sponsoring the current needs, bearing some of the operating expenses and funding the building maintenance issues using portion of the amount contributed so far by the KODAVAKOOTA members	\$ 1,500
3.	Kodava Clan: It's a website that provides immense cultural insights, inhabitants information, family names & trees, facts on Kodava festivals, food, jewelry, ancestral information and much more. The members of KODAVAKOOTA will have free access to this website once its fully integrated into our new website. The contribution is to keeping the website running, upgrade content on periodic basis, annual hosting charges & other maintenance related expenses	\$ 1,000
